Willy's West Coast Wander. Corbiere lighthouse to Plemont Bay 14km Walk 8

Starting from the lighthouse keepers house (if the tide is low you can walk out to the lighthouse if you wish) walk up the rather rough road and after 150m turn left at the top. The road descends, follow it around for 650m and you will reach some new apartments. Turn left towards beach, and after 100m follow the path around to the right, keep straight with the sea in front of you and after 1800m you reach La Pulente Hotel, this is a great place for food.

From the La Pulente Hotel you can take to the beach or walk along the track on the side of the road. Continue straight up St Ouen's Bay passing El Tico café and Big Vern's café (This one is of my favorites) and after 5000m you will reach the Jersey Pearl,(If you are walking on the beach continue right to the end of the beach to the small slipway). Go towards the car park opposite which is nearest to the sea and head down towards the sea wall. Continue along the sea wall until you reach a slipway. From here it is easier to walk on the beach, and after 1000m you come to a small slipway at the very end of the beach.

Continue straight at the top of the slipway, do not turn right keeping the big bunker on your left.

Question. What sort of business is operated from this bunker.

Continue up the main road(Route des Havres), and after 150m you will see a sign on the left, Cliffpath to Gronez, take this path up the steps keeping the sea on your left, after 500m you will see a big gun on your right.
